Visit to Network Rail Holgate Depot Holgate, York

15th May 2024 at 4.00pm

The first visit for 2024 will be to Network Rail's Holgate Depot at Holgate, York on Wednesday 15th May starting at 4.00pm.



Holgate Depot is Network Rail's largest engineering works facility which includes a 12-acre maintenance building. Specialist trains are prepared, maintained and serviced at the depot.

The visit will be followed by a meal at the Carlton Tavern in Acomb.

The depot is a busy round-the-clock operational facility and Network Rail requires all visitors to wear full PPE:

- Hi Vis Orange tops (jacket or vest)
- Hi Vis Orange bottoms (leggings or overtrousers)
- Hard hat
- Safety boots
- Safety Specs

Note the Hi Vis PPE must be Orange

For members and guests who don't have Hi Vis Orange PPE, the Society can loan Hi Vis Orange vests, overtrousers and hard hats for £10 per person. Members and guests will be responsible for providing safety footwear and safety specs.

Network Rail will be limiting the number of visitors to 15 (to be confirmed) and it would be appreciated if you could confirm whether you wish to attend along with the names of any guests no later than Friday 26th April 2024. Please add whether you would like the Society to provide you and any guests with the PPE at £10 per person and include sizes for vests (S – M – XL – 2XL -3XL) and overtrousers (S – M – L -XL -2XL – 3XL – 4XL).
