## Visit to the Yorkshire Wolds Railway

**2.00pm Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> May 2026**

The Yorkshire Wolds Railway was established in 2008 and opened in 2015; it runs volunteer-led diesel train rides on a 1,000 ft demonstration line situated on the former Malton & Driffield Junction Railway. It is based at Fimber Halt near Fimber:
